

Thunder & Lightning

When we lived there, we found that Southern California has many natural features which are wonderful in their grandeur and beauty. The sequoias, Death Valley, and coastal surfs with sun drenched beaches were all within a day's drive of our home. You just couldn't beat it. But there was something missing - thunder and lightning. It did happen occasionally (three times in seven years), but the last time I heard about it there was one bolt of lightning accompanied by almost inaudible thunder; I was inside and missed the whole thing.

In Sierra Vista, Arizona we had a monsoon season which had memorable lightning shows and thunder that made grown men cry for help. The storms could be seen from miles away as they formed over the Huachuca (Thunder) Mountains and slowly moved toward the San Pedro valley. In the evenings, lightning would make it as bright as daylight for several seconds at a time and the thunder would echo from the Mule to the Whetstone, to the Dragon mountain ranges. It was awesome. I loved to stand on the porch and watch the show unfold in front of me.

It was fun, it was beautiful, it was powerful, then one day it was real close. I was on the porch waiting for something to happen when all the hair on my neck and arms stood up. (If I had any on my head it would have done the same thing.) The lightning was so close I never did figure out where it actually struck - it just instantaneously blinded me. At the same time, my ear drums were attacked by a sound that almost knocked me to the ground. Suddenly the whole experience went from awesome to frightening. Being too close to the power source scared me and I went into the house.

Some people treat Christianity as if it were thunder and lightning. They really enjoy the show as long as it is far off - as long as it does not directly affect their lives. But let it get too close and they are afraid of what it might do to them; of the changes it might make in their lives. Too bad they cannot see that the "power" of God in Jesus is not destructive but protective. God protects his faithful from the "flaming arrows" thrown by Satan and shields them from Satan's thunder.

It is an awesome show - you ought to participate in it.
