

A People Of Faith

Politics is a wonderful thing to watch. Well, I don't know how "wonderful" but it does get interesting at times. Just listening to some of the arguments and the logic behind them makes one wonder just how far people will go to win favor and power. In the news recently there has been a debate over the subject of "faith" and religion as a qualification for a president. One candidate said a Muslim should not be considered for the office while others say a person's religion should not matter as long as he/she is a person of "faith."

Of course that raises the question of whether a Buddhist, Hindu, Voodoo priest, Wiccan, or any one of hundreds of "faiths" should be considered for the position of leader of the nation. The problem we face is one of understanding where the "faiths" would base their decision making processes. We think that ultimately everyone thinks like we do. That is, somewhere along the line that person will have a moral standard that matches ours. A simple look at the nations where the leadership is dominated by people of those faiths will show that to be a false assumption. But we think that the person will give up the tenants of his faith because he is now leading a "Judeo-Christian" nation.

It is like appointing someone who is not qualified to be an elder hoping he will grow into the position – he won't. When it comes down to it, everyone is a person of faith. We have to ask, "Faith in what?" The Hindu president will either have to give up his faith or do away with the meat industry and make cows holy. The Muslim president would have to replace the sharia law of his faith with American law – if he is really a person of "faith" he cannot do it. Some people have faith in religion, others have faith in themselves but if their faith is genuine they will be loyal to "faith" over their loyalty to the nation.

All this said, as a Christian, I must understand that it is not the "faith" of a president that matters but it is MY faith in Jesus that must remain true.
