In The News?

“Bettina the Orphaned Bushtail Possum Finds Comfort in Toy Kangaroo.” “Husband Says He's Been Forced to Live on Front Yard for Months.” “Jennifer Aniston Hates Flying Coach. Can You Blame Her?” Those are actual headlines from a Wednesday morning internet news service. They did share the page with some actual news, but one has to wonder why they were considered to be “news” in the first place. It really makes me reflect on how the Bible might have been “headlined” if it were written in today’s world.

Of course there would be the major headlines with the stories contained in the politically correct language. “Alleged son of God can’t carry his own cross.” Or perhaps, “Prophet loses his head after party.” Maybe Jonah’s story could be found under the headline, “Prophet makes fish so sick it vomits.” After things like that, each headline becomes more vague in order to get people’s curiosity level up enough to click on it.

Headlines are OK in a newspaper or on the internet – often they focus attention on pointless/meaningless stories that might not be read otherwise but will bring in advertising revenue. Usually when I read them, I am sorry I wasted my time. To be perfectly honest, I don’t really care what kind of toy a possum plays with. Bible stories, on the other hand, have a point – they are there so lessons can be learned and examples can be followed.

The Bible is not a book of headlines it is the story of life. It is not just news, it is Good News. God does not need an editor to enliven interest; he needs people whose interest has been piqued through the stories of sacrifice and victory. Victory in Jesus, that is.
