Pull Over!

Several years ago I had to attend a meeting on Ft. Huachuca in Sierra Vista. It was one I really wanted to attend but I was running late. It was being held on a part of the fort I was not familiar with and I could not locate the building. Since it was in the dinosaur days (the ancient time before cell phones and GPS), I decided to do the only reasonable thing and ask for directions. (Yes, a real man does that sometimes but only when there is no woman in the car to give him instructions.) It was about that time an MP turned in front of me at an intersection. My immediate thought was, "Pull him over and he will tell you where to go." That seemed reasonable so I pulled up behind him and flashed my lights. He kept going. Then I flashed my lights again and honked to be sure I had his attention. He just kept going and after about two miles of this I decided he was never going to pull over so I called it quits. I finally found my destination but I was pretty late. After that I decided it was futile to try to pull over a cop – until this week when a Miami woman made the news for pulling over a speeding cop.

She was in a 40 mph zone when the officer in his squad car passed her at a high rate of speed. He did not have his emergency lights or siren on so she turned on her camera and followed him. At one point she estimated his speed at 100 mph – she was going 80 and could not keep up with him. Finally, she got his attention and pulled him over. When he asked if there was an emergency, she replied, "Just your speeding." He told her he was on his way to work and guessed he was going a little fast. He promised to slow down. She posted the event on the internet where it was seen by the officer's boss who said "appropriate" action would be taken and the woman would not be given a ticket admitting she was going over 80.

I can think of several lessons this might illustrate. First, nobody is above the law; not even those who enforce it. Several Pharisee passages come to mind for that one – you can look them up. Second, you never know who is watching you.

These days they just might have a camera. Third, be careful who you tell you were breaking the law in the same way he was; not everyone has a forgiving boss. Fortunately, as a Christian you are blessed with a savior who is always ready to forgive a repentant heart.
