The Price of Hope

"Atezolizumab." Sound familiar? Probably not, but it is something people are willing to pay a high price to obtain. It is a new treatment for advanced bladder cancer. It is for those patients whose cancer has traveled to other parts of the body and whose diagnosis is terminal. In a study just completed, the drug stopped the tumor growth in 24% of patients and caused them to shrink by 30%. It is a drug that gives hope to patients where none existed before. That is good news. Patients who had been given a life expectancy of six months now have that extended to, perhaps, eighteen months. Hope for an extra year of life.

Reading between the lines, it also means the drug was ineffective in 75% of the patients who tried it. I liken it to the bag of corn chips I picked up the other day that had in very bold lettering, "New Larger Bag." Note that I now know the bag is larger but not one word was said about whether it contained any more corn chips than the old smaller bag or if it was sold at a new larger price. I could only hope I got some kind of bargain. With the new drug, however, the idea of a bargain is dashed from the beginning.

The cost of the treatment is \$12,500 – per month. That extra year of life will deplete your savings by \$150,000 and will benefit you only if you are in the 24% group. That is the price of hope that the drug company believes you will be willing – and able – to pay. The explanation of their pricing went something like this, "It's a price that is fair, given how well it saves lives and given its cost of development." I'm not sure I am totally impressed with a choice between a 76% failure rate and an additional year of cancer treatments and misery as the disease progresses. More slowly, yes, but still progressing to death.

If the above sounds cynical, it is because, as a Christian, I have a very different outlook on the cost of "hope." It really is very expensive but the price has already been paid by Jesus on a cross. My hope is not 76% doubtful with a 30% maybe; but is assured through a 100% sacrifice that was made on my behalf. The only doubt involved is whether I will commit my life to living for Jesus. Christians are not progressing to death but to life in eternity. Faith is the "assurance of things hoped for." What kind of faith do you have?
