Lessons From The Pufferfish

The pufferfish is an interesting organism. When threatened or frightened, it can instantly ingest huge amounts of water (or sometimes air) and blow itself up into an odd looking ball-like creature that scares away the threat. When blown up they look much larger and more dangerous than they really are. Actually, their greatest danger comes when they are in their normal state. Almost all pufferfish contain enough toxin to kill thirty adult humans if it is ingested, so they are pretty much left alone to do their thing when swimming in the ocean. There is one species of fish, however, that is immune to their poison. Sharks can eat them for lunch and never get indigestion.

Now let me seemingly change the subject for a bit. How big is the LGBT community in the US? In a 2015 survey of on the street heterosexuals, the majority guessed the "gay" population to be between 25 and 30 percent. Others who have paid a little more attention to what is going on guessed it to be around 10 percent. The real number according to both gay and straight sources is between 3.2 and 3.8 percent – or roughly 9 million out of a population of 320 million. (About: LG – 1.7%, B – 1.8% and T - 0.3%.) These are the movie, TV, and news broadcasters who believe themselves immune to the destruction that is a part of the blowfish make-up and who think they are doing the world a favor by portraying them as a huge, harmless group of society's best. In the end the toxins of the LGBT's will destroy everything it touches. If you do not believe the Bible's warnings, just read some secular world history – Greek, Roman, etc., your choice.

When engaged in their practices, they cannot reproduce, they can only recruit. They blow themselves up into something the world finds both fascinating and fearful – don't be taken in by a pufferfish – it is neither.
