The Price of --- Beauty(?)

What is your idea of "beauty"? If you could look into a full length mirror and imagine the ideal "look," what would it be? I believe I have written about Pixee Fox in the past but the Swedish electrician turned American model has made the news again. She has had dozens of surgeries and spent tens of thousands of dollars to make herself look like the person of her dreams – a cartoon character. At first she wanted to resemble Tinker Bell, but lately she has fixated on Jessica Rabbit. She made the news this time by having six ribs removed in order to achieve a sixteen inch waist.

She said that had been her goal from childhood but most children grow up when they realize cartoon characters don't exist outside of make-believe. In addition, all those surgeries had to have resulted in a great deal of pain and the removal of ribs will give her a lifetime of pain and discomfort – and for what? Just so people will look at her.

Perhaps I can come up with a better suggestion. If you want people to look at you, act like a Christian. Doubtless that will make you quite unusual in your circle of friends. As someone has said, "It will impress some and amaze others" – but either way you will be a topic of conversation. Jesus proved that by his walk on the earth and he has told us to walk in his footsteps.

If you really want to be beautiful by removing things, remove sins from your life. It is not painful and the resulting life will be a beautiful thing to behold.
